
- ❖ When an account is created for a student, s/he receives a Welcome Email from **engagement@rosettastone.com**.





- ❖ The log in details for the app are the same as for the web access.




How to Sign In to the Rosetta Stone Learn Languages App

- ❖ Tap the "Sign in" option.





- ❖ Tap "Work or School."






Start the Course

- ❖ If a student is in B1-C1 level, s/he will be placed in Fluency Builder.




Foundations

- ❖ Each unit has 4 lessons.




