



## Green travel settlement rules for students / graduates under Erasmus + KA131 projects, starting from the academic year 2022/2023.

1. Ecological means of communication recognized by the Erasmus + program are: bus, train, bicycle, and also carpooling (joint travel of people on the same route and for the same purpose, in the car of one of the co-passengers). Traveling by other means of transport does not meet these conditions.

2. Students / graduates may apply for a lump sum for travel costs resulting from the implementation of a trip by low-emission means of transport (so-called "green travel"), if such a trip covers more than half of the route (on its major part), taking into account a round trip. Such persons submit a declaration regarding planned course of the journey, with an indication of the means of transport, to the Erasmus Program Coordinator (Annex 1).

3. In justified cases, a student / graduate may apply for additional individual support for living expenses for a maximum of additional 4 days of travel (both ways in total). In order to do this, complete the appropriate boxes in Appendix No. 1.

4. The number of additional days granted (one way travel) depends on the distance between the seat of the WAB and the seat of the host institution, calculated with the use of an online calculator available at the website of the European Commission (EC): http://ec.europa.eu/programmes/erasmus-plus/tools/distance\_en.htm, according to the following distribution list:

Distance	Number of days
Distance 0-700 km	1
700 km or more	2

5. Additional "green travel" funding, if awarded, shall be paid together with the other components of the Erasmus + scholarship.

6. The declared method or time of travel shall be confirmed upon return by submitting a statement of green travel (Attachment No. 2) to the Erasmus Coordinator, together with the evidence listed in the statement.

7. If the trip is not confirmed in the above-mentioned manner, the student / graduate will be requested to reimburse the amount resulting from the "green travel" entitlements.
