Additional Accepted Proofs of English Language Proficiency:

- A diploma of completion of first-cycle (Bachelor's), second-cycle (Master's), or long-cycle Master's degree studies in the field of Philology (in the relevant foreign language) or Applied Linguistics, issued by a higher education institution operating within the higher education and science system of the Republic of Poland or a foreign university, together with a diploma supplement or certificate confirming that the number of hours of classes in that foreign language was at least 500.

- A diploma of completion of first-cycle, second-cycle, or long-cycle Master's degree studies, issued by a higher education institution operating within the higher education and science system of the Republic of Poland or a foreign university, which:

- includes information about the language of instruction, or

- if the diploma does not specify the language of instruction, it must be accompanied by a diploma supplement or certificate confirming the language of instruction during the studies.

- An **International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma**, with reference to the main language of instruction.

- An **European Baccalaureate Diploma**, with reference to the **first (L1) or second (L2) language**.
